

From the Outback to the Reef



The Diocese of Rockhampton in Central Queensland, Australia, offers exciting opportunities for ministry.

Covering an area of 800,000 square kilometres from tiny outback communities, mining towns and regional centres we are looking to the future confident in God's plan for the church in this region.

We are embarking on a Mission Action Plan seeking to train and resource people for mission and ministry and are looking for expressions of interest from women and men who are confident in their faith, gifted in managing change and excited by the challenge of serving God in Central Queensland.

We have opportunities in the following towns:

Winton – Dinosaur Country

A small vibrant community. The Parish is supported by BCA and is looking for a priest in charge who will engage with the wider community and grow the church while helping to develop a sustainable ministry plan for the Western Region.

Moranbah – Coal Country

A mining town of about 7000 people is looking for a priest in charge to further develop and train the people involved in mission and outreach programmes in the community. This position is supported by BCA.

Emerald – Gem Country

With a population of around 15000 Emerald is one of the larger centres in the Diocese. The town has a strong mining and agricultural base. The church is looking for a priest in charge to continue the existing growth and to explore new ways of doing ministry in the region.

Theodore and Moura – Coal, Cattle, Cotton and Crops

The towns of Theodore and Moura need a part time leader who will help them to explore new ways of doing church, someone to provide guidance and encouragement as they explore where God is at work in their communities.

Gracemere

Gracemere is a relatively new satellite town for Rockhampton whose population has doubled over 10 years. This region needs a person to help them minister to young families.

Is the major city servicing Central Qld, located on the beautiful Fitzroy River, 30mins from the Capricorn coast. There is an opportunity for a children's/youth minister as well as a church planter.
